MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER It

has been another very positive week in school and the children are continuing to work hard in class. We are pleased that our attendance remains high and the children are able to access learning and enjoy coming to school. I continue to feel so proud of all of the pupils here. They are doing so well.

It remains extremely important that any child with symptoms of Covid stays away from school, to avoid the risk of spreading infection to others, including the more vulnerable. Over the last week we have seen a number of children being referred for a Covid 19 test in accordance with national guidance. If your child has been in close contact with a confirmed case, they will be asked to self-isolate at home. Please DO NOT try to get your child tested unless they have developed the symptoms of COVID19 (high temperature, new, continuous cough, loss of sense of taste/smell).

In preparation for any school closures related to Covid 19 we are going to begin to use Microsoft Teams for Years 1-6 for spellings and homework as of next week (week beg 28.09.20). Reception will continue to use Tapestry. To begin, either visit https://www.microsoft.com/en-gb/education/products/teams or download the App for Teams. You will be asked to log in. Children's log ins are their first name followed by a full stop then their surname and then the school email, eg. joe.bloggs@wreningham.norfolk.sch.uk

We will be asking you to change the password in the future for security reasons but to begin with please leave it as it is so we can clear up any issues swiftly as we get set up.



- -> Here you can see any recent activity within your team such as new assignments added. Your teachers will respond to returned assignments here.
- -> Chat allows you to speak to your teacher. You begin a new chat by clicking on this icon— type your teachers name to send them a message.
- -> In teams you can see any teams you are a part of—this should be your year group.
- -> In assignments you can see any current assignments set by your teachers.

You can also access all of this information and important files by clicking on 'Activity' or entering your Team page, both will give you the following menu across the top. Teachers may upload important documents such as spellings or letters to the 'files' section.



We appreciate this is new for everyone and will take some getting used to for us all. This is why we have decided to begin using it as soon as possible. It will give us all time to adapt should this technology become necessary to continue quality education for our pupils. Teams will be used when individual pupils self-isolate or if the school need to close bubbles or enter another lockdown.

Come and join the school team! We have an MSA position. If you enjoy working with children, helping them to play outside, this
