Attendance at school The Government remains very clear that schools must aim to have the highest attendance possible for all of their pupils so they can achieve their best. Research has shown children often do not catch up on work missed, which can have serious consequences for their learning and progress. In exceptional circumstances parents can complete a leave of absence form to apply for a leave of absence in school term time. Exceptional circumstances could be a medical, dental or optometric consultation, a religious observance, a one-off significant family event or circumstance, an elite sporting, musical or drama activity. Head Teachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time for any other reason.
