

# School Council Bring and Buy Sale

School council would like to ask everyone not to throw away old toys/games because on Thursday 9/1/20 there will be a bring and buy sale. The school council will start collecting toys, games, books and DVDs in good condition – not dirty or damaged – from next Monday 9/12/19. The toys can be purchased on the day for 20p, 50p and a £1 and there is a limit of £2 to spend.

# The school Christingle service this year takes place at All Saints' Church, Ashwellthorpe starting at 2PM.

Although the school has booked 2 coaches that can seat 110 persons in total, we also need some parents to volunteer to take the remainder of the children to and from the church. If you can volunteer please speak to the school office.

#### Attendance and Punctuality

We remind parents of the importance of being in school on time and that children arrive promptly to prevent disruption to their learning and that of others. There have been a few families routinely arriving at school later than 8.50 a.m. School starts at 8.50 a.m. every day. Children need to be in their class by this time so they can start their lessons.

Pupils who arrive late are greatly disadvantaged because they miss starting the day with their peers. They may miss the beginning of lessons and be unsettled. It is also very important that children establish good routines and habits in preparation for the rest of their lives. Lateness can also be disruptive to the school office, ordering dinners after the register has been completed. We are required to monitor children's punctuality and attendance: On-going lateness (after the class register has been taken) could be classified as an unauthorised absence.

We do understand there may be rare occasions when you are unavoidably late due to unforeseen circumstances. Thank you.
