COVID-19 Home School Agreement

The school will do its best to: Provide a school environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection; Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs; Contact parents and carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19; Inform you as soon as possible if staff, or children, in your child's class bubble have a positive test for covid-19 – they will have to self-isolate for 14 days; Communicate between home and school through a regular newsletter and on the school website; and also by telephone, email, FOWS Facebook and by letter; Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy (and including the 'Seven Bees of Behaviour') as well the expectations outlined in this agreement; Work with you to solve any concerns or problems which may affect your child's progress or behaviour at school. We will continue to follow the information from the government, Public Health England and the local authority and will adapt our practice as needed to ensure both staff and children remain safe. THIS AGREEMENT CAN BE FOUND ON THE SCHOOL WEBSITE	To help the school community, I know and understand that: If my child has COVID-19 symptoms, we will get tested and I will let the school know the result as soon as possible; If anyone in my household has a positive test for COVID-19, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family; If a child in my child's class bubble tests positive for Covid-19, I will collect my child from school immediately; the class bubble will be shut for 14 days; When dropping my child off at their drop off/collection point, I will adhere to the social distancing rules and will stick very closely to the staggered start and end times; I will wear a face mask when dropping off/collecting my child from school; When working remotely at home While TEAMs is being live streamed into a home, everyone must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner including dress, language behaviours and home environment. This includes ensuring that your camera and microphone is turned off; I will support my child/ren to access work safely (e.g. such as adding parental controls etc.) when they are working remotely at home; I will make the school aware if my child is sick or otherwise cannot complete their work; I will contact school if I do not have a device at home for my child to complete their work online.	I will do my best to: Come to school in full uniform and wear my PE kit to school on my PE days; Be safe - cough and sneeze into my elbow or tissue catch itbin it-kill it, put the tissue in the bin and wash my hands; Follow the social distancing rules around the school and avoid mixing with children from other class bubbles as much as possible; Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds and wash my hands after using the toilet each time, before lunch and after playtime and when I first arrive in school; Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others; Not bring things into school from home unless the teacher/school has asked me to such as my snack, reading diary, drink bottle etc. When working at home I will complete my work to the same standard as I would in school and complete my work to the deadline set by the teachers; Alert my teachers if I am not able to complete my work and seek their help if I get stuck. We know this will be difficult for our younger children to understand but we will keep explaining it to them and encouraging them all the time and ask you to do the same.
