Cooking homemade sausage rolls. They were really easy! All I needed was puff pastry, sausage meat and an egg (for glazing).



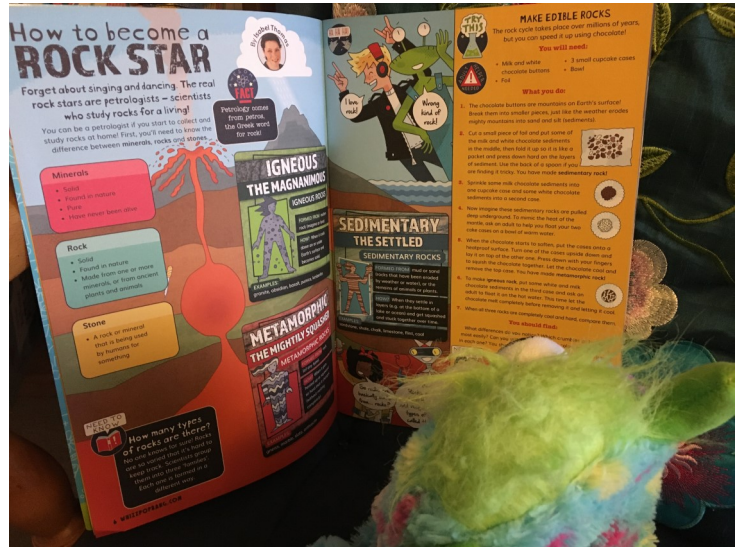
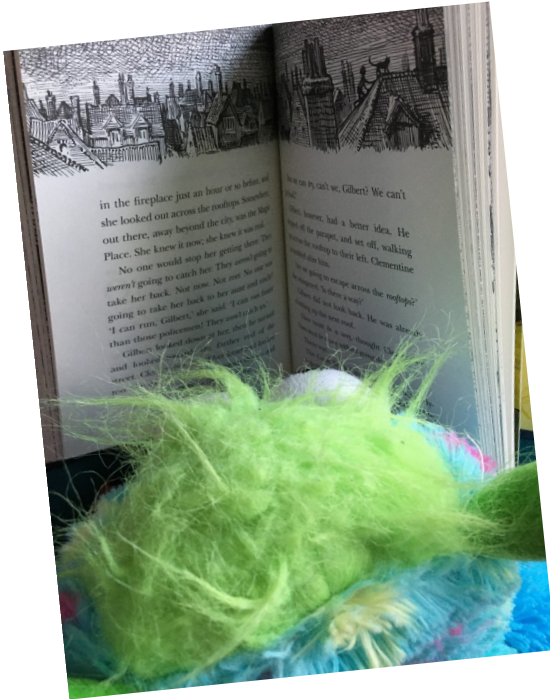
