Looking up at the clouds.

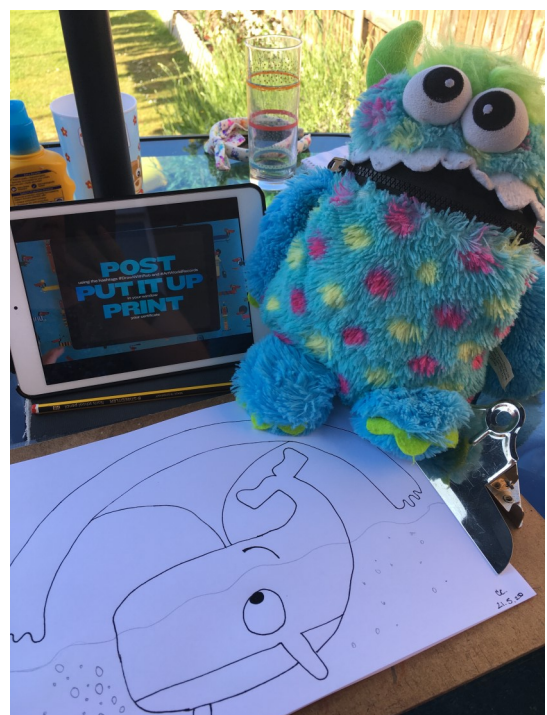
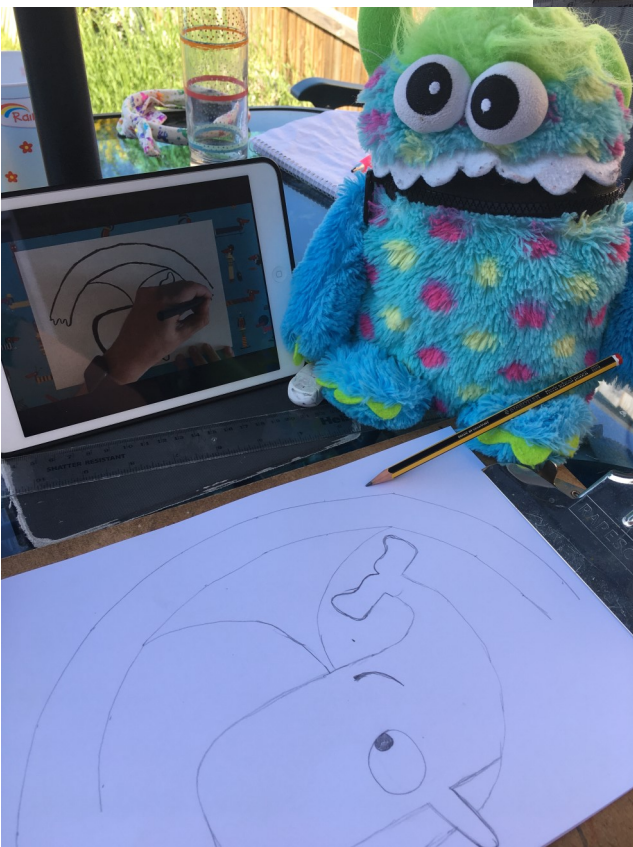
What do you think this group of clouds looks like?

Getting Mrs Cameron's shoes ready for her. She's been out running with her daughter this past week!



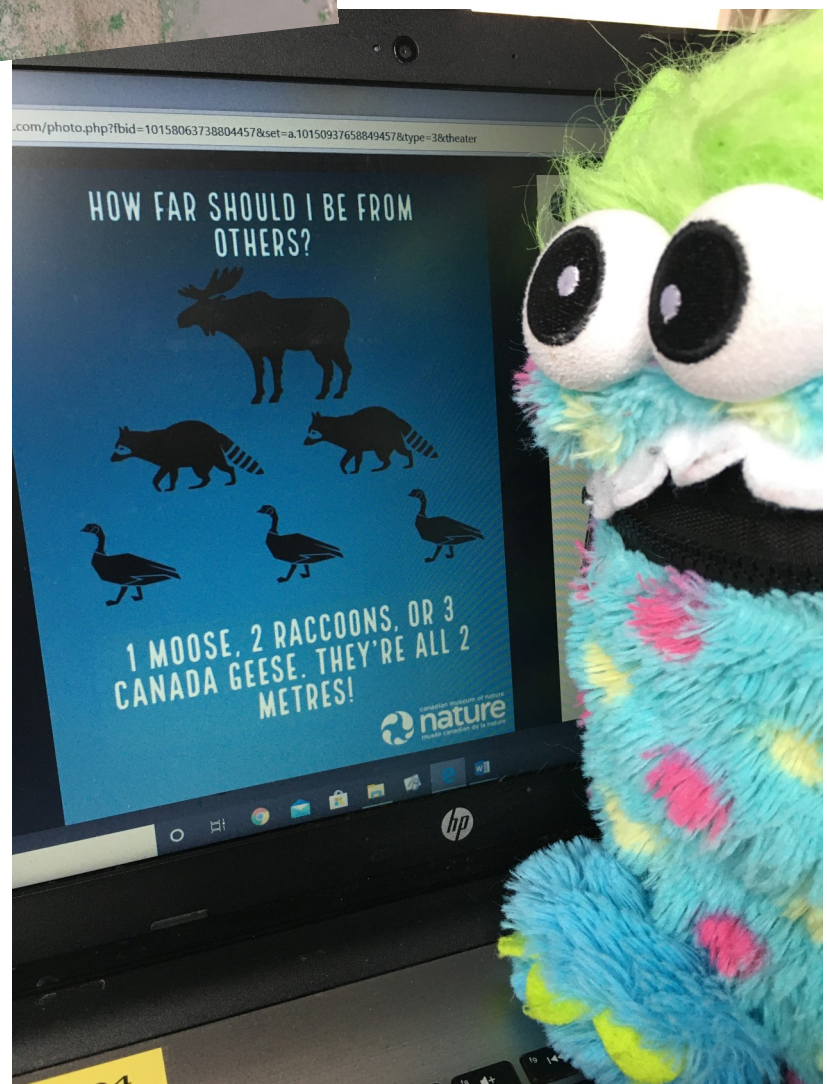
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Joining Mrs Cameron's
