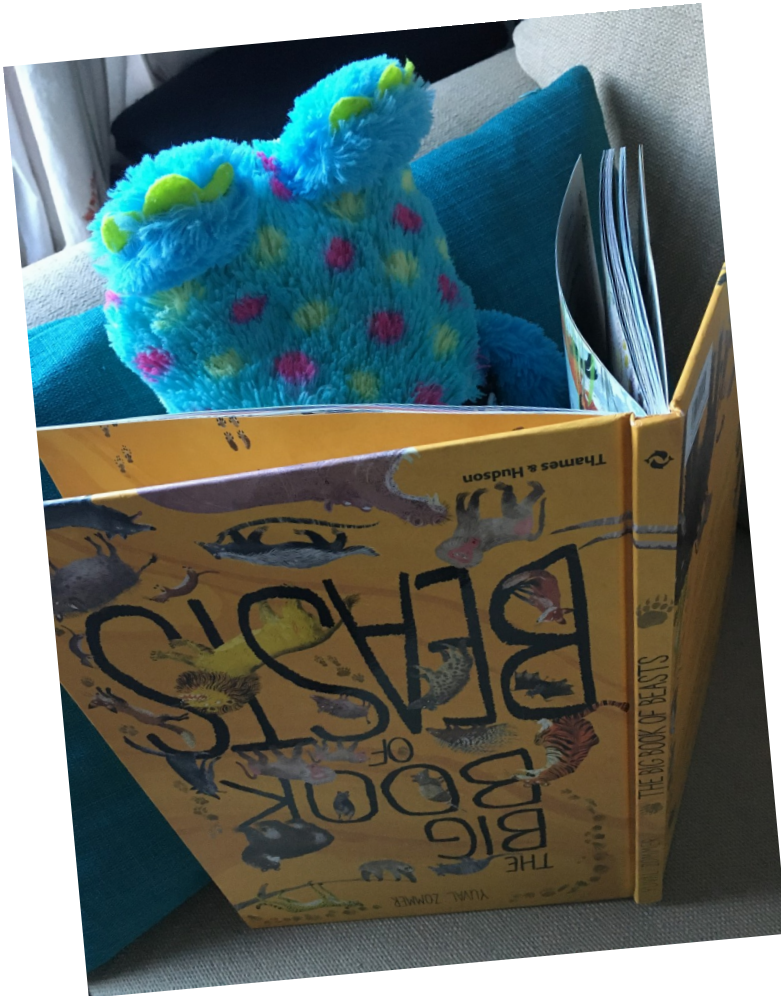

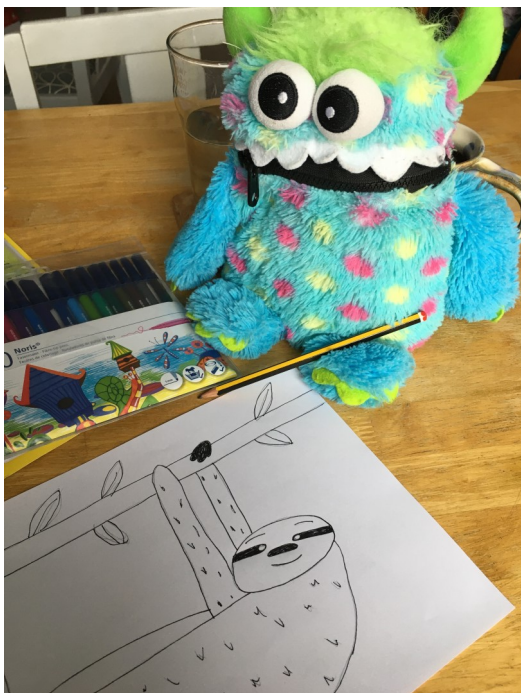
# NR3 SAFARI
