Some reminders as we start the new term:



Please ensure your child has a coat in school for playtime and outside learning as the weather starts to turn autumnal.



If your child needs an inhaler please ensure that a **new one has been given into the school office together with an up to date asthma care plan.** These will need checked and updated at the start of each term please.



Mobile phones are not allowed in the school buildings. Children do not need a phone in school but should they have one for a specific reason they will need to hand it in to the school office at the start of the day. Any visitors will also be asked to hand in mobile phones.

Please remember the cut off for lunch orders each week is **8am on Monday morning.**

If you need to change a lunch request after this time please speak to the office. Please note that all 'paid for' meals for KS2 children (year 3 to year 6) must be paid for in advance as the school is unable to carry debt for school meals.



Please also remember to send your child/ren in with a labelled bottle of water and a **fruit/ vegetable snack only.** **Allergen Awareness** – We would like to make parents aware that we have children in school with severe nut, sesame, egg and gluten allergies. We are a **nut free school** and we request that no nut based products are sent in with your children. Thank you.



Individual and sibling school photographs will be taken on Monday 22nd September. Pre-school children can be photographed with their siblings at drop off time. Please can all children come into school wearing full school uniform. If it is PE day please bring PE kits to change in to. Thank you.
