The Gloucester Shipwreck Talk – we are sure that you have heard about our most incredible visit on Wednesday from Julian and Lincoln Barnwell, the Norfolk divers who discovered the Gloucester shipwreck along with their friend, James Little.



The shipwreck was discovered in 2007, with its identity being confirmed in 2012 and more recently, in June 2022 the fascinating discovery was made public to the world. This royal ship was carrying James Stuart, Duke of York and heir to the throne and on 6th May 1682, ran aground off the Norfolk coast.

Julian and Lincoln showed the children a short film of their discovery, detailing some of the history of the shipwreck, insight into the extent of their dives, the wonderful moment when the shipwreck was discovered and images of some of the artefacts recovered so far.

The children all listened intently and were in awe of this wonderful piece of history. Lots of carefully thought of questions were asked and the answers were clearly leaving them wanting to know more! Well done to Phoebe C, Oliver H and Henry W who each won a book of the history of the Gloucester, for their questions. Changing the Length of the School Day – we would like to inform parents that with effect from 15th April 2024, we will be increasing the school week to 32.5 hours. This change is based on non-statutory guidance from the Department of Education. **What does this mean?** Registration for Class 1 and 2 children will be at 8:30AM (drop-off from 8:25AM) and for Class 3 and 4 children, registration will be at 8:40AM (drop-off from 8:35AM). Registers will close at 9AM for all classes and if arriving after this time, children must be signed in by their parents at reception. The end of the school day will remain the same as it is currently. The parent consultation period for this change is from now until 8th March 2024 and should you have any comments/ questions about this change, please write in to office@wreningham.norfolk.sch.uk. Any feedback will be raised with Governors and the final outcome will be shared on 22nd March 2024.
