“EGGCITING” NEWS– it’s the Easter Egg Drop Challenge next Friday. Don’t forget to bring your egg and dropping equipment. It is sure to be a cracking morning for everyone! The Rules:

- No parachutes or balloons!
- At least ¼ of the egg should be always showing so the children must not completely cover the egg with any material.
- It should be possible to clearly see a part of the egg as it is housed in the design.
- The design must not include changing the egg in any way (no tape or nail polish on the egg!).
- The container must be able to be opened once dropped so that the condition of the egg can be checked!
- The inside materials must be designed to allow a raw egg to be easily inserted and removed.
- The eggs will all be dropped from height outside or in the school hall (weather permitting)!
