Fixed penalty notices for unauthorised absence - as communicated at the end of the Summer term, we would like to remind parents that in line with DfE policy, Norfolk County Council issues fixed penalty notices (FPN) for unauthorised absence from school where any pupil has missed at least 9 sessions (4.5 school days)

The fine is £60 for each parent or carer. It rises to £120 each if not paid within 21 days.
