We will be holding another Phonics meeting for KS1 parents to attend after the Easter holidays, on Wednesday 27th April.


Attached to this Newsletter email are various flyers for activities happening over the Easter holidays and Mothering Sunday.

Covid Update – We currently have three case of Covid in school.

The 2022 Egg Drop Challenge is Thursday 31st March!

- At least ¼ of the egg should be showing at all times so the children must not completely cover the egg with any material.
- It should be possible to see a part of the egg when housed in its design.
- The design must not include changing the egg in any way (no tape or nail polish on the egg!).
- The container must be able to be opened once dropped so that the condition of the egg can be checked!
- The inside materials must be designed to allow a raw egg to be easily inserted and removed.
- The eggs will all be dropped from height onto the school playground!
- No parachutes or balloons!
