learning phonics will have a decodable book + e-book and all pupils should bring home a 'sharing' book. Please record **all** reads in their reading records (R-Y4 online BOOMreader/Y5+6 reading record). These are the percentages of pupils recording 3 or more reads per week in each year group from the week 7^{th} - 13^{th} November.

R = 6% Y1 = 0% Y2 = 6% Y3 = 13% Y4 = 14% Y5 = 93% Y6 = 100%
