You should all have received an email and menus for the Christmas lunch by email yesterday. Please

pre-order your child/children's Christmas meal by Thursday 27<sup>TH</sup> November deadline.

Please note that jacket potatoes and school packed lunch options will not be available on this day - so if your child does not want a Christmas lunch they will need to bring a home packed lunch.



You should have received an email to advise there has been a case of head lice in school.

According to NHS guidance, if your child has head lice, treat it as soon as you spot them. You can treat head lice without seeing a GP. Check everyone you live with, or have close contact with, and start treating anyone who has head lice on the same day. There's no need to keep your child off school if they have head lice. us to do so, with specific instructions as to dosage/timings/refridgeration. These need to be handed in to the office please. We are unable to administer medicines without this. Please also ensure you also provide the medicine – we do not generally hold stocks of calpol or ibuprofen, so you need to provide these. All medicines must be labelled with your child's name please and collected when the medicine is to stop. Thank you.
