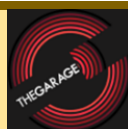

They are for families with babies, children and young people from conception until they reach the age of 19, or up to 25 for young people with special educational needs and/or disabilities.

School and Community Team SCTs are a dedicated resource available across Norfolk to **complement and enhance the work schools do with children and families.** By offering early, targeted support, the teams help **improve outcomes for children with SEND.**

A reminder of the email that was sent home earlier in the week concerning the drop off and pick up arrangements:

Following a safeguarding audit and considering recent national events, we have updated our school access procedures.

Morning Drop-off

Children should continue to line-up in the playground at the appropriate drop-off times (8:25AM for reception to year 2 and 8:35AM for years 3 to 6).

Parents should not enter the school via the door by Class 2, if you wish to speak to a teacher or the office, please come via the main entrance.

Children should not be left unattended in the playground before the drop-off times and remain parents' responsibility until the bells are rung.

Jody's Club

For children being dropped off in the morning, please do so via the main reception and ring the doorbell. Jody will receive the children from here.

For collection, if the children are outside with Jody, please collect from the staff carpark and your child will be released into your care from here. If the children are inside, please go via the main reception and ring the doorbell.

After-school Clubs and Tutoring

Following the trial of collecting children from the staff carpark, it has become apparent there is a safety element to consider with the significant number of parents picking up at the same time; for example, limited visibility of the road and staff driving out of the carpark.

Therefore, we ask parents to wait by the top gate by the main entrance and children will be released from here at the end of the club or tutoring.

If your child is being collected before the end of the club, please let the person running the club know and your child should have their belongings with them whether in the main hall or at the recreation playing field.

We appreciate your co-operation with these changes and trust you understand that safeguarding is paramount to our school. Best wishes, Ms Leader
